DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS:

- The department is open to all schools in Vernon County. Exhibits will consist of a school booth display representing the entire school or a subject taught within the school. All displays will be in place by 6:00 p.m. on entry day.
- No advertising brochures allowed in exhibit for school.
- JUDGED AT 8:00 A.M. ON THURSDAY MORNING.
- Premiums will be paid to school.
- A plaque will be presented to the top Class A, B and C exhibits plus a merit ribbon to best overall exhibit by J & R Military Surplus.
- Merit Award given to Judge's Choice
- Booth space is limited so please return entries early so we can allot space to as many different county schools as possible.
- If more than 14 booths are entered, the fair board or superintendent makes the decision as to who will be entered.
- NO PAINTING, COLORING or WRITING on WALLS.
- Thank you for your cooperation.

BOOTH EXHIBIT REGULATIONS:

- The booth shall show a variety of educational activities carried on in the school.
- The booth materials must be pupils' work and should be a natural outgrowth of daily teaching learning school experiences.
- The booth may have a theme as well as audio and moving visual aids.
- The booth shall have a name or banner telling the school it represents.
- If the booth represents a particular room or department, it should be so indicated.
- Each booth shall have attached on right-hand wall a label telling the schoolroom or department and class.
- Booths shall be divided into the following classes below.
- Booth sizes are approximately 7.5 ft wide x 8' deep x 8' tall.

JUDGING

- Booths will be judged on educational value, audience appeal, appearance, creativity, student representation and connection to the current years Vernon County Fair theme.
- Awards will be given on the Danish System according to the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
